Dying man leaves words and songs of hope for others

Abu Samah Bin Mohamed's days are numbered. The 62 year old, a patient of HCA Hospice Care (HCA), was diagnosed with terminal liver cancer in February this year – by then, the condition had progressed so far that conventional treatments proved ineffective.



Despite the shock of the devastating diagnosis, Abu Samah Bin Mohamed remains positive and optimistic, fuelled by his love for his family. The cheerful man is also an enthusiastic musician, a lifelong passion that began when he first picked up the guitar at 16.

He does not have much time left, but one of his last wishes is to leave messages of hope and positivity for other palliative care patients and their families. To fulfil his wish, HCA has been organising video recordings of his singing and guitar playing, and personal messages.
